The CDA credential requires a total of 120 CDA training hours overall:

- 80 hours—10 hours in each of the 8 subject areas below
- 40 hours—in any of the subject areas of your choosing

CDA Subject Areas

1. Planning a safe and healthy learning environment (via LearnERS)
2. Advancing children's physical and intellectual development (via LearnERS)
3. Supporting children's social and emotional development (via LearnERS)
4. Building productive relationships with families
5. Managing an effective program operation
6. Maintaining a commitment to professionalism
7. Observing and recording children's behavior
8. Understanding the principles of child development and learning
